## Our Priorities



### Ease Traffic, Clear the Air & Fight Climate Change

- ✓ Clean our air and reduce asthma rates by setting high targets for clean transportation
- ✓ Make it easier for Angelenos to leave their cars at home by incentivizing new ways of commuting
- ✓ Protect the health of families living near the Ports of LA and Long Beach, as well as those living near freeways, by creating a special clean corridor for moving freight



### Make Public Infrastructure Green

- ✓ Upgrade roads and freeways to capture increasingly scarce rainwater
- ✓ Cool down the city by planting trees next to streets and use cool pavement on roads
- ✓ Commit to the highest level of building and landscape standards for all facilities and projects managed by Metro
- ✓ Restore habitat and other natural resources with Metro mitigation funds



### Provide Options for Healthy Mobility

- ✓ Create a robust regional greenway network, by building bike paths and walking areas along stormwater channels and abandoned rail lines
- ✓ Develop safe, comfortable connections to transit, job centers, schools, markets, and parks
- ✓ Provide transit to parks and green open space so all Angelenos can enjoy nature



### Ensure All Angelenos are Well Served by Metro

- ✓ Maintain affordable fares for public transit
- ✓ Protect residents priced out of their neighborhoods due to construction of new transit stations
- ✓ Hire local workers for Metro projects, especially in building walking and biking projects which yield 46% more jobs than building freeways
